- In case the price bid is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, the tender will be completely rejected, and the bidder is liable to be banned from doing business with PGB.
- Do not quote a price in the Technical Bid, i.e., in Part-I or elsewhere, which would lead

to the bid getting disqualified without any further reference to the bidders.

- The prices must include all the applicable taxes and duties, fees, and any other charges except GST. GST component, if applicable to be shown separately and will be paid extra if applicable.

No claim for compensation from the Contractor shall be entertained due to any variation in quantities (irrespective of the quantum of variation) OR deletion of any item. The rates fixed for the contract shall remain the same throughout the contract period. Actual executed quantities shall be measured and paid. The rates will be applicable to other similar works in the Bank as and when required by PGB.
23.	Assignment and sub-contracting	The Contractor shall not assign, sub-contract, or sublet the whole or any part of the contract in any manner. Terms & conditions

Rate shall be inclusive of all wastages of materials, erection, and fixing to the best workmanship manner.

The actual size installed at the site is to be measured and paid. **(No extra payment to be made for wastage of material, lead, and lift of material to any floor, and working in add hours)**

The rates shall be for all heights & levels and be inclusive of necessary consumables. The rate shall include the necessary scaffolding required for this work.

Rates to be inclusive of moving existing furniture where required, placing it again, removing debris, cleaning all finished surfaces of unwanted paint/polish smudges, adhering foreign material, sharp edges, etc.

PGB will not provide any supporting items like ladders, necessary tools/tackles, or equipment that the contractor needs to bring to the site and keep in a safe place.

Special Terms & conditions

STRUCTURAL STEEL

- Structural frame will be designed as per IS 875 part III
- Structural frame will be fabricated from structural steel. Make Apollo/Jindal. All tubular sections will be cold-bended (up to CHS 165dia) to preserve the structural strength of the sections.
- The structural members will be fabricated in as large segments as possible to minimize field joints.
- All segments of the assembly will be welded properly as per IS6013 and/or 7018; all sharp edges and corners are grinded.
- All plates are CNC cut so as to have the best finish.
- The steel shall be buffed and shall be epoxy painted after a coat of epoxy primer (with spray/brush) for a good finish. Touchup of welded area /scratch area will be done by brush at the site. (Make Berger/Asian Paint)
- Nut & Bolt joints, standard joints reinforcements are done for steel structure.
- For anchoring, mechanical anchors (Make Fischer/Ace) would be used

FABRIC

- Fabric patterning is done considering the prestress, structure form, welding joints, and fabric elongation properties. Membrane form finding and patterning is achieved by computer-based finite element analysis software by experienced engineers.
- Membrane cutting, seaming, and HF welding as per Euro standards on FIAB machine. All fabric patterns are plotted on fabric rolls by a CNC plotter and CNC welded on a high-frequency welding machine in dust-proof conditions.
- Self-tapping screws will be used for fixing aluminum profiles to MS sections.

DESIGN

- ✓ The structural design shall comply with applicable codes and regulations of Indian Standard/ BS/ AISE.
- ✓ Engineering Design documentation of the complete tensioned membrane structure shall meet all applicable codes of AISE /Euro Code III or equivalent.
- ✓ The structure shall be designed for loads in accordance with the IS:875 with the basic wind speed applicable to the site as per IS:875 Part-03
- ✓ Reference to other international codes/standards can be made at times when necessary guidelines are not available within Indian Standard.

ENGINEERING

This part of the specification document covers the basic engineering requirements for this structure.

Engineering calculation: It should include primarily the following items

- Design basis & criterion clearly mentioning the parameters and characteristics for all the materials that are being used for this tensile fabric structure
- Basic data used for generating wind loads and pressures, along with loading diagrams.
- Large deflection numerical shape generation that will ensure a stable, uniformly stressed, three-dimensionally curved shape that is in static equilibrium with the internal pre-stress forces and is suitable to resist all applied loads.

- Confirmation of fabric strength – contractor to confirm that the fabric specified in this document is satisfying the technical requirement based on fabric analysis.
- Finite element structural analysis of the support frame system. Member sizing calculations of all primary structural members.
- Connection design, including bolt, weld, and ancillary member sizing.
- **Engineering drawings:** In general, all submissions shall be made in minimum A3 size. All drawings shall include critical dimensions, specifications, grades of materials, connections, anchoring, and foundation details necessary to understand the submission. The engineering submission is to include primarily (but not limited to) the following drawings.
 - GA drawing of the structure with the pre-stressed fabric – to include the plans and elevations
 - Structural framing drawings – to include plans and elevations along with the basic sizes of the primary structural members
 - Layout and details of foundation and anchoring
 - Details of connection between structural members, fabric connection to structural framing, specific connections critical to the structure, etc
 - A General Seam layout of the fabric, typical seam joining details, fabric reinforcing details, etc.
- **Structural Authenticity:** All drawings and calculations shall be signed and sealed by a specialized engineer mastered in membrane structures from any certified University. This engineer is responsible for this authenticity shall hold the following minimum basic requirement. Holding a master's degree in membrane structures from any recognize university.

WARRANTY

- ❖ General Defect liability period is one year from the date of completion and handing over.
- ❖ Warranty on Tensile fabric shall be 10 years on Pro rata basis. During the warranty period, the Manufacturer will have to, at its own cost, repair/replace the fabric during the 100% warranty. The TFS needs to submit the tensile fabric manufacture's undertaking for the same mentioning the tender name and TFS authorization along with the tender bid and also submit the warranty terms and conditions as well.

STRUCTURAL STEEL FRAMING

- Structural frame shall be fabricated using structural steel of standard shapes as per the architect's/client's requirement.
- No hot bending of the structural section is allowed.
- The fabrication of the steel shall be in accordance with guidelines set forth in the AISC steel design manual and the AWS code of structural welding. The fabrication activity shall be performed at the factory only – Not at the site. All welds shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's design and performed prior to shipping.
- The structural members shall be fabricated in as large segments as possible, thereby reducing the number of joints.
- All segments of the assembly will be welded or stamped with the appropriate part number in a manner that will still be visible after the painting is applied.
- Fabricator to grind all corners and sharp edges in order to avoid damage to fabric.

CABLES AND END FITTINGS

- This part of the specification is applicable wherever there are requirements of cables and associated fittings.
- All structural wire rope shall be made from Wire Rope conforming to AISI Steel Cable Manual requirements with a galvanized coating or approved substitute.
- All cables and end fittings shall be delivered in clean way.

BOLTS AND RELATED FASTENERS

- Fasteners and hardware accessories shall be of types and sizes best suited for the purpose as recommended by the specialized membrane structure engineer.
